In their free time, the guys will grow fry, feed, care for them, so that later they will be released into the natural environment.

Many lakes in our area are very clogged with silt. In such conditions it is difficult to survive and fish dies. Lakes, rivers lose their inhabitants every year, overgrown with abundant vegetation and losing the opportunity to restore their strength. They need help. In nature, there are species of fish that eat a huge amount of vegetation. For example, grass carp helps clean moderately and heavily overgrown water bodies, for this it is necessary to increase the number of carp to a thousand individuals per hectare. The amount of food consumed by grass carp often exceeds its body weight.

Building nurseries, teaching children to breed and grow fish requires the presence of specialists in this field, but if you think about what result everyone can expect in the end, then this technology can be of great benefit to the state and the environment.

The technology of cleaning water bodies and growing fry in the school area will help the children realize the importance of protecting the environment from pollution. They will see the result of their work and feel the joy of their own participation and real contribution to the preservation of the natural wealth of their region. We are the future generation of our earth, it depends on us what our planet will be like, what our ecology will be like. We must not only talk about this in class and debate, but also help with our knowledge and work. So, our future is in our hands!
